Year Round in Park City and Kamas

June 2<sup>nd</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup> – Ragnar Relay Wasatch Back

Bring together your friends and family and form a team for this 200-ish mile race with teams of 12 runners. Make sure to wear your wackiest costume while you run and rock out to live bands. The race runs along the backside of the beautiful Wasatch Mountains beginning in Logan and finishing at Soldier Hollow, in Midway UT.

June 17<sup>th</sup> – Savor the Summit

Join in the fun at Park City's longest dining table during Savor the Summit's Grande Table event. One long dinner table graces the center of Main Street allowing for over 1500 diners to join in the celebration of wonderful food, alfresco dining, live music, and summer in the Wasatch!

July 4<sup>th</sup> – Independence Day Celebration & Fireworks

Come up to Park City and spend the weekend. Take in the tunes of an outdoor concert, watch a rodeo, and make sure to enjoy the 4<sup>th</sup> on Park City's Historic Main Street for the annual parade. Other events for the day include a 5K run, pancake breakfast, live music, rugby game, and beer gardens. Make sure to stay awake for the fireworks from Park City Mountain Resort just after dusk.

July 6<sup>th</sup> – 9<sup>th</sup> – Park City Food and Wine Classic

Come and experience the extravaganza that is the 13<sup>th</sup> annual Park City Food and Wine Classic. This is a premier event where master winemakers, culinary greats, and distinguished guests gather to play, wine, dine, and just have a great time in Park City!

July 1<sup>st</sup> – August 5<sup>th</sup> – Utah Symphony/Utah Opera Deer Valley Music Festival

Sitting outside under the warm summer sun and cool mountain breeze listening to music...it does not get better than this! The Deer Valley Music Festival is the Utah Symphony/Opera's summer home in the hills. This will be the 14<sup>th</sup> season of chamber music, classical opera, and pops offerings in four venues including Snow Park at Deer Valley Resort.

July - September - Big Stars, Bright Nights

The Park City Institute brings its 15<sup>th</sup> season of outdoor concerts to Snow Park Amphitheater at Deer Valley Resort. This year's performers include X Ambassadors, Kellie Pickler, Aloe Blacc, Smash Mouth, Cracker, The Romantics and many more.

August 4<sup>th</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> – Kimball Arts Festival

This year is the 48<sup>th</sup> Annual Park City Kimball Arts Festival, one of the top art festivals in the country. Find treasures from more than 200 artists and other vendors. Have a good time listening to music from 30 live banks and refreshments from 3 wine and beer gardens. Even the little ones will have a great time at the Kimball Kid's Corner.

The tour of Utah is a premier showcase of international professional cycling competition that takes place in Utah every year. The event features some of the steepest climbs and fastest descents in pro cycling and winds through various nearby cities, including Heber Valley.

With its md August date, the races give runners the chance to experience the beauty and cooler weather of late summer in Park City. Get your running shoes ready for this intense, high altitude run.
